

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MELAWOOD SUPAMATT

The Silky smooth and luxurious Melawood Supamatt range help reduce the visibility of fingerprints.

Melamine foam (Magic eraser)



As with other matt surfaces visibility of oily finger marks cannot always be entirely concealed but with the right care and cleaning this can be avoided or at the very best kept to a minimum.

Daily Cleaning

- Any chemicals and liquids that can cause stains must be wiped away immediately with a damp cloth and soapy solution.
- Do not overly wet the surface and always prevent any moisture from penetrating any unprotected or exposed edges.
- For daily wiping, always use a well rung out damp, soft, lint free cloth with clean water.
- For removing daily grime, always use a well rung out, damp, soft, lint free cloth with mild soap and water solution.
- Diluted window cleaning products are great for removing drying marks and smears on surfaces. (1 part window cleaner to 2 parts of water)
- For oily marks use a dry or well rung out damp or melamine foam. Example of melamine foam is the magic eraser.
