

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR QUARTZ/ENGINEERED STONE

Please note this is just a standard guideline. There is different type of engineered stone. Ask your installer for more detail.

Daily Cleaning

- Clean with a mild detergent, water, and soft cloth.
- To remove adhered material such as food, gum, nail polish or even dried paint, first scrape away excess material with a plastic knife and then use a damp cloth to remove any marks or residual dirt.
- A non-abrasive cleaner can be used along with a non-scratch sponge for particularly tough dirt or stains.

How to prevent damage to your stone

- Avoid using metal knives or utensils directly on the quartz.
- Use hot pads or trivets for pans, crockpots, and electric skillets.
- Avoid pressure or force on your engineered stone countertops, as the stone can chip or crack.
- Avoid direct sun exposure.

Do not use...

- Bleach
- Trichlorethane
- Solvents
- Oven Cleaners

- Scouring pads
- Methylene chloride
- Ammonia
