

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SOLIDWOOD

Please note this is just a standard guideline.

Daily Cleaning

- Wipe with a clean dry cloth.
- Regular cleaning will help to avoid build up dirt that can dull the finish.
- Dusting will remove the tiny particles that can scratch the surface. Use your favourite furniture polish.
- Stubborn dirt should be wiped with a wrung-out cloth that has been immersed in a solution of soap and water. Follow the grain of the wood. Dry off immediately with a clean dry cloth.
- Oil treated wood is recommended to be oiled once or twice a year or whenever the wood looks particularly dry.

How to protect your wood.

- Water should never be used in excess amounts.
- Ammonia should never be used on wood. The chemical will damage the finished surface.
- Stay away from any harsh chemicals.
- Do not place heat sources directly on wood.
- Strongly coloured fluids can leave a mark if not cleaned up immediately.
- Protect from sun to avoid sun bleaching.
- Always use coasters, backing or placemats.

Do not use...

- Ammonia
- Bleach
- Glass cleaners

- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Steam cleaning machines
- Abrasive cleaning products
