

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR HARDWARE

Hinges

Dirt and grime can build up. Oils, lubricants, and coatings should protect hinges. Remove dust, debris, and any existing moisture by regularly cleaning the door by wiping or washing it. Thus, will reduce the likelihood of rust. If any build-up has begun to affect the functionality of the hinge, silicone sprays work well to break down build ups.

Regular lubrication can prevent squeaky noises, reduce wear, and tear, and ensure the hinge operates smoothly. Apply rust-inhibiting coatings or lubricants to prevent rust formation.

Runners

To clean your runners, remove the drawer and wipe down the slides with a soft cloth or brush. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasives that may damage the runner. Lubrication is necessary to ensure that your drawer slides operate smoothly.

Handles

Do not use harsh chemicals. Overtime chemicals can soften and wear the handle finish off which could affect your warranty if applicable. A diluted mixture of PH neutral detergent and warm water is sufficient for cleaning handles. Scrubbing too hard can also end up removing the plating.

Rust is not covered under most product's warranty therefore we recommend Wurth's protective wax. It is a highly transparent wax anti-corrosive agent that displaces water.
