## CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MELAWOOD

## Daily Cleaning

- Melawood does not require any sort of furniture polish.
- Use a damp, soft, lint-free cloth to remove grime, followed by an absorbent soft paper towel or microfibre cloth to dry.
- Always prevent any moisture from penetrating any unprotected or exposed edges.
- For stubborn dirt use a mild soap and water solution with a soft cloth followed by an absorbent soft paper towel or microfibre cloth to dry.
- For tough dirt a soft brush can be used. Take care not to cause mechanical or moisture damage around sensitive areas like edges and joins.
- Diluted window cleaning products are great for removing drying marks and smears on surfaces. (1 part window cleaner to 2 parts of water)

## Do not use...

- Acetone
- Methyl ethyl ketone (MEK)
- Amyl-acetate
- Butyl acetone
- Caustic Soda
- Chlorinated solvents
- Cresols/Phenols
- Ethyl-acetate
- Halogenated solvents
- Xylene
- Detergents with strong acids
- Power scouring pads and steel wool

• Abrasive compounds like washing powder, furniture cleaner and bleach.

- Thinners
- Ammonia
- Benzene
- Butyl & Methyl alcohol
- Cellusolve
- Chloroform
- Dichloromethane
- Glacial acetate acid
- Toluene
- Steam cleaning equipment
- Solvents
